

38th Annual Cortez Commercial Fishing Festival

February 15 & 16, 2020

The Florida Institute for Saltwater Heritage, Inc. (F.I.S.H.) a non-profit 501c3 organization is now accepting applications for the 38th annual Cortez Commercial Fishing Festival. Cortezians welcome the public to their historic village (est. 1887) for two days each year to increase awareness of the commercial fishing issues, regulation and practices. Volunteers (residents and friends) organize this massive event.

In 2018 paid attendance was 17,000. Profits from the festival have been used to fund the FISH Preserve, 100 acres on the east side of the village bordering Sarasota Bay. There is an ongoing habitat restoration throughout the entire preserve that will recreate our unique coastal habitat for the public to enjoy, complete with trails and educational signage. We have been very successful with bringing grant money to the effort, but all grants are partnerships and our most important partners are our members, neighbors, participant and volunteers. FISH has also purchased significant historic buildings for preservation and community use. FYI:

- 60 juried exhibitors
- 2D or 3D work (or surprise us)
- 70% of the work must reflect commercial fishing, historic preservation, the Florida
 - coastal ecosystem, local flora + fauna or traditional craft.
- Spaces are usually 12' x 12' but may vary slightly depending on location
- All work must be the original design of the exhibiting artist
- Artist must be present
- Artists are responsible for the collection of 6.5% Florida state sales tax
- No t-shirts except for art shirts
- Set up starts Friday, Feb 14th @ 10 a m, all day and before 8:30 am Saturday
- The entrance gates open @ 9 a m Saturday
- The festival entrance is on 119th St @ 45th Ave. W. in Cortez (off Cortez Rd. CR 684) just west of the Bradenton Beach Bridge.
